## **Teachers Day**

World Teacher's Day has a rich history dating back to 1966 when the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural

Organization (UNESCO) and International Labour Organization (ILO) established the special Intergovernmental conference on the status of teachers in Paris. This conference adopted the UNESCO/ ILO recommendation concerning the status of teachers which outlines teachers' rights and responsibility. Therefore while teachers day was first celebrated on October 5, 1994 to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the 1996 conference, from then it has become an annual event recognized globally as an occasion to acknowledge and honour the remarkable contribution of teachers to society.
